

Committee Roles & Responsibilities

The FRLA's mission is to PROTECT, EDUCATE and PROMOTE the hospitality industry.

The FRLA Central Florida Chapter's purpose is to support the hospitality business growth through the provision of government access, staffing platforms and visibility.

LEGISLATIVE TASKFORCE COMMITTEE: This committee will assist members in staying informed about local and legislative news, events and initiatives that concern our industry, while engaging with active and motivated members in the community and local officials to create synergistic results.

Time requirement: 15 to 20 hours minimum annually

- Maintain open communication with local legislators and policy makers to build synergistic relationships with FRLA chapter members.
- Monitor local City/County agendas and communicate needs for action/s as necessary

HOSPITALITY WORKFORCE COMMITTEE: This committee will either create or partner with Career Fairs in Central to serve as ambassadors filling the employment gap.

Time requirement: 15 to 20 hours minimum annually

CHAIRPERSON: CHRIS UNWIN. ECOLAB

- Identify industry staffing needs and forge stronger partnership, support, mentorship and communication with already existing Career Fair Events and opportunities
- Foster relationships with Superintendent, Deans and other educational leaders: High School Pro-Start Culinary Programs & the Hospitality Tourism Management Programs (HTMP), Instructors/Students, Culinary Institutions, Colleges & Universities, Academy of Hospitality and Tourism
- Serve as selection panel for scholarship applications, as needed.
- Foster relationships with Superintendent, Deans and other educational leaders.

<u>FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE</u>: This committee facilitates fundraising opportunities that support hospitality education programs, raise awareness about the hospitality industry and FRLA, and build networking opportunities for FRLA members and future members.

Time requirement: 15 to 20 hours minimum annually

- Facilitate the acquisition of event sponsors, raffle donations, prizes for events.
- Facilitate in event logistics (establishing event goals; cost estimates; venue, date/time, speaker, entertainment selection)
