

Statewide Curfew Guidance for Essential Goods and Services

Businesses critical to supply and maintain essential goods and services, that impact the health, safety and wellbeing of Floridians, to areas under curfew restriction will be considered to move under curfew hours by possessing and presenting to local officials when challenged:

- A valid government-issued ID, such as a Driver's License or passport;
- Proof of Employment, such as Employer credentials or a letter on employer letterhead; and
- A Demonstrated Need to enter the area, such as a work order, inventory list, or employer authorization. Local officials know their communities and are well suited to facilitate a safe and timely reentry process.

State and local officials are working together closely to ensure the safe and timely movement of necessary resources throughout the state.

Disasters affect all members of the community and we must be prepared to work together to meet the needs of all citizens during an emergency.
